1. Welcome, Call to Order

Members of the UFLSWG discussed the assessments that were presented to the Studies Subcommittee (StS). The StS did not provide feedback.

WECC will not be doing further assessments but will complete the current assessment. The Planning Coordinator's (PC) will be responsible for future assessments. Assessments are required to be done every five years although, they have been done every two years.
