

WREGIS Account Holders can ‘accept’ or ‘dispute’ generation data that has been reported. ‘Disputed’ generation data will not be included in certificate creation.

To accept or dispute current period generation data, follow the steps below.


Accepting and Disputing Current Period Data

Step One:


In the Asset Management module—

Option 1: Select the **Generator Plant Unit Name** from the dropdown and click **Review Data/Self Report**.

Option 2: Click the current period date in the **Review Data/Self Report** column.





Step Two:

Select the **Period Data Status** for the desired vintage on the Generation Self-Report/Unit Output Data Review screen.

Step Three:

Review the reported data for accuracy on the Accept/Dispute screen, then click **Accept** or **Dispute**.

Why dispute data?

RECs cannot be un-created. Any RECs issued in error are deducted from future vintages. To prevent future vintages from being impacted, disputing the data to prevent REC creation may be the best option.

NOTE: Once generation data has been disputed by an Account Holder, it must be reloaded before certificates can be created.

Additional Information

Generation Data Status Definitions	
WREGIS Accepted	Generation data has been reported and certificates will create on Day 90 if no action is taken.
Pending	Additional action is required by the Account Holder (fuel allocations) or WREGIS staff (failed feasibility) before certificates will be issued.
Disputed	Account Holder has disputed the generation data reported and certificates will not be created unless reloaded.
Account Holder Accepted	Account Holder has accepted the generation data reported.
Admin Accepted	WREGIS staff has accepted the generation data reported.
Certificate Created	Generation data has processed through the issuance cycle and certificates may have been created.
