# RAC Studies

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Coordinate and collaborate with the Reliability Assessment Committee (RAC) and resource planners to study and highlight resource adequacy and resiliency issues throughout the Western Interconnection



# Market Development

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- Monitor development of markets throughout the Western Interconnection for impacts to reliability
  - Day-Ahead Markets development
    - CAISO's Extended Day-Ahead Market (EDAM)
    - SPP's Markets+
  - Real-Time Markets
    - CAISO's Western Energy Imbalance Market (WEIM)
    - SPP's Western Energy Imbalance Service (WEIS)
  - Western Power Pool's Western Resource Adequacy Program (WRAP)

# Seams Between Markets

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Monitor seams issues that may develop between Day-Ahead and Real-Time markets that are developing throughout the Western Interconnection

# Greenhouse Gas

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Monitor development of greenhouse gas tracking and accounting within the developing markets throughout the Western Interconnection
