## TRAX / Light Rail

One of the easiest and most convenient ways to visit WECC and downtown Salt Lake City is to use the nearby light rail service. Access to the <u>TRAX Green Line</u> is only a few yards from our building.



### **SLC International to WECC**

The <u>Airport TRAX Station</u> is located on the ground level, outside the terminal, on the east side. Passengers should exit door 1A and go east. Board the <u>TRAX Green Line</u> and, five stations later, exit at the North Temple Bridge/Guadalupe stop. Continue down the bridge toward the Salt Lake Hardware Building on the left. WECC is on the second floor.

### **WECC to SLC Downtown**

The Arena TRAX Station (one stop past WECC) starts the <u>Free Fare Zone</u>, making it even easier to get around downtown for dinner, entertainment, and sightseeing.
