IBR Registration Initiative Q4 2024 Update Posted

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Consistent with its [Inverter-Based Resource Strategy](#), NERC is dedicated to identifying and addressing challenges associated with inverter-based resources (IBR) as their penetration continues to increase.

In addition, FERC issued two orders with directives to NERC regarding IBRs: (1) an [order](#) directing NERC to identify and register owners and operators of currently unregistered bulk power system-connected IBRs; and (2) [Order No. 901](#) directing the development of Reliability Standards addressing multiple aspects of IBR planning. Working closely with industry and stakeholders, NERC is executing a FERC-approved [IBR Registration work plan](#) and an [Order No. 901 Work Plan](#) to achieve these directives within the prescribed timeframes.

NERC's [IBR Registration Initiative Q4 2024 Update](#) showcases progress made, highlights key activities in Legal, Registration, Standards, Stakeholder Outreach, and E-ISAC Engagements, and provides available resources. This update was developed as part of NERC's ongoing efforts to ensure industry and stakeholders are kept informed throughout this critical, three-phase project.
