Draft - 2025 ERO Reliability Risk Priorities Report

Comment Period: July 7, 2025– July 18, 2025

The main objectives of the 2025 ERO Reliability Risk Priorities Report (2025 RISC Report) are to identify key risks to the bulk power system (BPS) that need attention and to recommend actions to mitigate these risks. This report sets itself apart from other NERC reports by offering the industry strategic guidance on current and imminent risks, as well as their mitigation strategies. In contrast, reports such as the State of Reliability or event analyses focus on reviewing data from previous years or specific incidents to draw objective conclusions about past events, emerging risks, and appropriate monitoring strategies for mitigation.

Additionally, the 2025 RISC Report complements NERC's Long-Term Reliability Assessment, which evaluates potential future scenarios over the next 10 years based on data. The conclusions and priorities presented in this report reflect the collective data, input, and opinions of RISC members, industry stakeholders, policymakers, and subject matter experts regarding present and emerging risks. A draft version of the report is now available on the NERC website for a 10-day industry review and comment period. A link is provided below.
