1. Welcome, Call to Order

Danielle Smith, Interchange Scheduling and Accounting Subcommittee (ISAS) Chair, called the meeting to order at 1:04 p.m. MT on May 2, 2022. A quorum was present to conduct business. A list of attendees is attached as Exhibit A.

2. Review WECC Antitrust Policy

Layne Brown, Reliability and Market Interface Consultant, read aloud the WECC Antitrust Policy statement. The meeting agenda included a link to the posted policy.

Jonn Fulkerson, Portland General Electric Company (PGE), reviewed action items carried over from the ISAS meeting on January 31, 2022. Action items that are not closed and will be carried forward can be found here.

6. Discuss and vote Christmas Eve/weekend to the WECC Preschedule Guideline

Mr. Fulkerson led a discussion on the WECC preschedule guidelines for Christmas Eve occurring on a weekend. Sam Adams, Tri-State Generation & Transmission Power Management (TSMD), and Mr. Fulkerson will update the verbiage in the 2022 guidelines this week. It will include examples of how holiday's that occur on the weekends will be observed. The final version will be submitted to the RRC for their approval during the June 2022 meeting.



7. Vote on 2023 Preschedule Calendar

The vote for the 2023 Preschedule Calendar will be voted on after the WECC's Preschedule Guidelines modifications are made.

8. NAESB Update

Mike Steigerwald, Bonneville Power Administration (BPA), presented an update on the North American Energy Standards Board (NAESB). The presentation provided an overview of the actives of the NAESB Wholesale Electric Quadrant across the lifecycle of standards development.

Craig Henry presented an update on the WECC Interchange Tool Working Group (WITWG). The vice chair is still vacant. The next proposed WITWG webinar suggestion is September 7, 2022.

10. Technical Committee RRC Update

Shelli Nyland, Project Coordinator, presented on the technical committee structure. The Joint Guidance Committee (JGC) is beginning the committee categorization review. The Reliability Assessment Committee (RAC) is revising their charter to align with the Reliability Risk Committee (RRC).

Vic Howell, Reliability Risk Management Director, presented on the (RRC), and the RRC charter. The RRC is working on developing the risk intake process, the three-year workplan, and the reporting process. ISAS discussed how the risk priority process works.

Ms. Smith led the discussion on merging the After-the-Fact Work Group (ATFWG) with the WECC Interchange Tool Working Group (WITWG). The ISAS discussed the purpose of the merge, and the pros and cons of the merge. The ISAS discussed the accounting documents, the balancing authority (BA) approval process, and if it should remain a working group. There was discussion on if a task force would be needed. An offline meeting will be held to compare the two charters, and to review the merge proposal.

12. New Vice Chair for ISAS

Ms. Smith led the discussion regarding the new ISAS vice chair. Sam Adams, TSMD, put his name in as a nominee. Mr. Fulkerson would like to be the next chair. Ms. Smith will send an email out to ISAS regarding the nominees.

The ISAS discussed holding the October 2022 meeting in person. By consensus the ISAS agreed to hold the meeting in person.
