

Underfrequency Load Shedding Work Group Meeting Minutes August 16, 2022

1. Welcome, Call to Order

Robby Anderst, Underfrequency Load Shedding Work Group (UFLSWG) Chair, called the meeting to order at 2:02 p.m. on August 16, 2022, MT. A quorum was present to conduct business. A list of attendees is attached as Exhibit A.

2. Review WECC Antitrust Policy

Kent Bolton, Senior System Stability Planning Engineer, read aloud the WECC Antitrust Policy statement. The meeting agenda included a link to the posted policy.

5. Assessment Simulation Results

Tyson Niemann, System Stability Engineer, presented the assessment simulation update for the Island Cases. Imbalances of 10%, 20% and 25% were presented for the South Island and the North Island light spring (LS) base case and the heavy summer (HS)3 base case. There were issues when running the 25% 2021 HS3 North Island base case. The system aborted after thirty-nine seconds and fell apart after the three second time frame. The spreadsheet showing what is being tripped will be emailed to the UFLSWG. WECC will no longer be running the future assessments, although WECC will continue to run the meetings. The final report will address that more work needs to be done and the Planning Coordinators (PC) will need to start a task force to further research the issues found. The goal is to reach 25% per area. The UFLSWG will need to discuss the assessment process moving forward. The UFLSWG would like to add this as a future agenda item for the PCs to review.



Mr. Bolton gave an update on the UFLSWG meetings. Due to the work being done on the assessment report, the UFLSWG will meet every other week for the next few months. The next meeting will be August 31, 2022, and will recur every other Tuesday.
