1. Welcome, Call to Order

Due to substantial feedback, the committee is going to have a two-week comment period on the posted charter. The comments will be discussed during the next meeting on December 13, 2022.

Mr. Anderst went through the draft 2022 UFLS Assessment Report and invited any input the committee members had. The committee discussed how to delegate tasks from the report and decided to start with a methodology document.
