Meeting Minutes

March 1-2, 2023

Salt Lake City, UT

1. Welcome, Call to Order

Chifong Thomas, Reliability Assessment Committee (RAC) Co-Chair, called the meeting to order at 1:02 p.m. MT on March 1, 2022. A quorum was present to conduct business. A list of attendees is attached as Exhibit A.

2. Review WECC Antitrust Policy

Enoch Davies, Reliability Modeling Manager, read aloud the WECC Antitrust Policy statement. The meeting agenda included a link to the posted policy.

15. Data Management Solution Project

Amanda Sargent, Senior Resource Adequacy Analyst, is looking for a vendor to increase security when collecting loads and resources data. A request for proposal was released for the data management project and the deadline was extended. A list of 70 technical requirements for the project was made available. The advisory group will be meeting to discuss suggestions.

Hamody Hindi, Department of Energy, presented an update on the National Transmission Planning Study.
