1. Welcome, Call to Order

7. Review Status of the Guidelines for the Design of Critical Communications Circuits

Victoria Ravenscroft, Sr. Policy and External Affairs Manager, gave a brief history of the Guidelines for the Design of Critical Communications Circuits. Three projects are currently using these guidelines. Ms. Ravenscroft also described the timeline for this document, which is a minimum of 45 days.

Because this document is currently undergoing technical review by WECC staff, the committee agreed to postpone reviewing this document until the next meeting.

8. Intertie Circuit Consolidated Data

Mr. Ashcroft provided an update on the intertie circuit consolidated data. During an internal WECC meeting, there was a discussion about whether it is appropriate for WECC to be the party responsible for this data.
