

Underfrequency Load Shedding Work Group Meeting Minutes March 21, 2023

1. Welcome, Call to Order

Robby Anderst, Underfrequency Load Shedding Work Group (UFLSWG) Chair, called the meeting to order at 2:00 p.m. MT on March 21, 2023. A quorum was present to conduct business. A list of attendees is attached as Exhibit A.

2. Review WECC Antitrust Policy

Kent Bolton, Reliability Assessment Engineer, read aloud the WECC Antitrust Policy statement. The meeting agenda included a link to the posted policy.

Mr. Anderst presented the Methodology Document. The UFLSWG reviewed the document and discussed which parts need to be revised.

Mr. Anderst commented to add a footnote drawing comparison between the generator frequency ride through models, to the ones we are including with the MBF, to the PRSC-24 models the one that running with these simulations.



Mr. Anderst commented on a section to be added on what generators were to be tripped. He stated that we are seeking PC input on which generators in the area are to be tripped by us. There was another section added by Mr. Bolton and me on unsuccessful assessment results. It is being reviewed for hertz violations or unstable generators. We will reach out to the necessary PC's copying the Studies Subcommittee (StS) and the Reliability Assessment Committee (RAC) members of the entity to come to a conclusion.

Mr. Bolton will reach out to NERC and see how other groups in the region are performing assessments.

Approval of the UFLSWG Methodology Document has been postponed until the next meeting.

7. Public Comment

Tyler Pearce, Arizona Electric Power Cooperative, Inc., asked if there is an assigned team to complete the UFLS assessments.

Mr. Anderst stated that is pending and the RAC will discuss this topic.

Mr. Pearce would like to know, if we will provide training for people providing their own frequency load shed. He suggested to have an "Open Training Session" on this topic.

Mr. Bolton stated Tyson Niemann will put together a presentation on how they ran these assessments.

Mr. Anderst stated that if anyone wants to be added to the group, they can let the UFLSWG know today.

Mr. Anderst needs assistance from the System Review Subcommittee (SRS) and he will seek out their help.

Mr. Bolton stated a group that deals with CEII requests should be distributed to the appropriate person. He will find out more information on this topic.
