1. Welcome, Call to Order

Ben Hutchins, Western Power Pool discussed how the Northwestern Power Pool, is now the Western Power Pool for business and rebranding purposes.

Jay Largo, Bonneville Power Administration asked if these names were unique to the western island names. The rebranding of the name is open to other entities.



Mr. Bolton will contact Legal at WECC, to discuss the name change for Western Power Pool and any implications. Also, anyone interested in editing the Off Nominal Frequency Load Shedding Plan document should contact Mr. Bolton.

7. Kick-off of 2023 UFLS Assessment

Mr. Anderst presented on the Underfrequency Load Shedding (UFLS) Assessment. He updated the group on the contract with California Independent System Operator (CAISO) listing all entity names.

Mr. Anderst and Tyson Niemann, Staff Engineer Reliability Modeling will meet with Power World early each month and provide updates to our group. He will ask if Power World would like to attend a future UFLSWG meeting.
