

System Review Subcommittee DRAFT Meeting Minutes Virtual

Day 1—August 15, 2023 1:00 p.m. to 5:00 p.m.

1. Welcome, Call to Order

Tracy Rolstad, System Review Subcommittee (SRS) Co-chair, called the meeting to order at 1:01 p.m. MT on August 15, 2023. A quorum was present to conduct business. A list of attendees is attached as Exhibit A.

2. Review WECC Antitrust Policy

Logan Affleck, Associate Engineer, read aloud the WECC Antitrust Policy statement. The meeting agenda included a link to the posted policy.

6. RAS Process Improvements

Nick Hatton, Staff Engineer, provided an overview on the process for Remedial Action Scheme (RAS) testing and base case building and improvements that can be made for both processes. Mr. Rolstad will discuss RAS data with the Reliability Risk Committee (RRC) and the Reliability Assessment Committee (RAC) leadership and will work with WECC staff to coordinate a training on RAS data.

Alex Stewart, Bonneville Power Administration; Richard Maguire, and Mr. Davies will develop a criterion for inclusion of projects into base cases. Mr. Rolstad and WECC staff will work to create opportunities for SRS members to give feedback on criteria for project inclusion in base cases.
