Meeting Minutes

October, 25—26, 2023

Virtual

1. Welcome, Call to Order

Chelsea Loomis, Reliability Assessment Committee (RAC) Chair, called the meeting to order at 1:02 p.m. MT on October 25, 2023. A quorum was present to conduct business. A list of attendees is attached as Exhibit A.

2. Review WECC Antitrust Policy

Enoch Davies, Reliability Modeling Manager, read aloud the WECC Antitrust Policy statement. The meeting agenda included a link to the posted policy.

3. Approve Agenda

4. Review and Approve Previous Meeting Minutes

Ms. Loomis introduced the minutes from the meeting on June 27–28, 2023.

7. System Review Subcommittee (SRS)

Tracy Rolstad, Grant County PUD #2, updated the committee on the SRS.

10. Near-term Production Cost Model Need and Application Discussion

Mr. Davies discussed the need for production cost models (PCM) and best practices to apply to the PCMs. Mr. Loomis, Mr. Rolstad, Mr. Harris, and Chifong Thomas, Thomas Grid Advisor, will work on developing a proposal concerning the use of back casting near-term PCM including defining the goals, determining the amount of work that needs to be done and along with assessing the reliability risks and benefits.

11. Model Validation Subcommittee (MVS)

Song Wang, Portland General Electric Company, provided an update on the MVS. The RAC reviewed the charter's modifications.

On a motion by Chifong Thomas the RAC approved the MVS Charter.

12. Long-term Transmission Planning Task Force (LTPTF)
