### 1. Welcome, Call to Order

Kevin Harris, Production Cost Data Subcommittee (PCDS) Chair, called the meeting to order at 10:07 a.m. MT on January 3, 2023. A quorum was present to conduct business. A list of attendees is attached as Exhibit A.

### 2. Review WECC Antitrust Policy

Jon Jensen, Reliability Modeling Engineer, read aloud the WECC Antitrust Policy statement. The meeting agenda included a link to the posted policy.

## 3. Approve Agenda

## 4. Review and Approve Previous Meeting Minutes

#### 5. Review Previous Action Items

Nicole Lee, Administrative Coordinator, reviewed action items carried over from the PCDS meeting on December 13, 2023. Action items that are not closed and will be carried forward can be found here.

## 6. Wind and Solar Capacity Factor Review

Arkadeep Das, Reliability Modeling Engineer, Associate II, presented the wind and solar capacity factor review. Further research is needed to determine the capacity factor differences. WECC will follow up with Tyler Butikofer, Energy Strategies, to discuss the differences seen with the wind and solar capacities and to clarify the mapping.



#### 7. Prices and Costs

Mr. Jensen presented prices and costs. The PCDS discussed reviewing the different prices. Mr. Jensen will add a link to the last cycle used for IEPR fuel price presentation and will provide it to the PCDS.

Jin Zhu, Hitachi Energy, provided an update on the wheeling rate options. The PCDS discussed seeing different wheeling rates. Mr. Jensen will identify units that are exempt from wheeling.

### 8. BTM Storage Data—Hourly Shape or Resource

Mr. Jensen presented behind-the-meter (BTM) storage data and led the discussion on using hourly shapes or resources. Mr. Jensen, Mr. Harris, and Mr. Zhu will review all energy storage options and will provide it to the PCDS. This will include generator types "pumped storage" versus "battery and pumped storage" options.

### 9. Update on Resources

Mr. Das will provide an update on resources during the next PCDS meeting.

### 10. 2034 ADS Schedule Recap

Mr. Jensen presented the 2034 Anchor Data Set (ADS) schedule. The gas prices will need to be implemented, along with verification of hourly wind, solar shapes, and BTM energy storage before the next cycle is run.
