

Production Cost Data Subcommittee Meeting Minutes February 14, 2024 Virtual

1. Welcome, Call to Order

Kevin Harris, Production Cost Data Subcommittee (PCDS) Chair, called the meeting to order at 10:03 a.m. MT on February 14, 2024. A quorum was present to conduct business. A list of attendees is attached as Exhibit A.

2. Review WECC Antitrust Policy

Jon Jensen, Reliability Modeling Engineer, read aloud the WECC Antitrust Policy statement. The meeting agenda included a link to the posted policy.

4. Review and Approve Previous Meeting Minutes

6. Announcements

Mr. Jensen presented an update on the 2034 Anchor Data Set (ADS) Production Cost Model (PCM) V1, which has the latest data from Intertek (VOM, etc.) and is waiting for the information from BC Hydro, and NREL for behind-the-meter (BTM) photovoltaic (PV) ratios and weightings for each bus. Ownership 2034 the definitions, bus, branch, and nomograms for El Paso have all been updated. The generation will be updated when the resources and information provided. When this is done, the V1 will be ready to run and validated.



7. 2034 ADS PCM V1 Report-out

Mr. Jensen presented the 2034 ADS PCM V1. Mr. Jensen received the latest data from Intertek (VOM, etc.) and BTM PV county information from Pacific Northwest National Laboratory (PNNL). Mr. Jensen is waiting for the information from BC Hydro, and NREL for BTM PV ratios and weightings for each bus. Jamie Austin suggested the focus be on 2034 ADS and V2.

8. VOM and Dispatch Price

Mr. Jensen presented on the dispatch price of wind, solar, and variable operations, and maintenance (VOM). Mr. Jensen compared the 2020 dollars to the 2024 dollars. Ms. Austin suggested that new data be used from now on.

9. AB32

Mr. Jensen presented on the AB32. The AB32 is a nomogram with the price penalty on imported Greenhouse Gas (GHG) to California.
