11. Public Comment

The SRS discussed Positive Sequence Load Flow (PSLF). Version 24 will be available soon but will be released later than originally expected. Version 23 will still be supported through 2024.

Some SRS members are still using PSLF version 22 and PSSE version 34, therefore, WECC will continue to post base cases in those versions on wecc.org. Nick Hatton, Reliability Modeling Staff Engineer, asked anyone using the older cases to notify him when they are no longer needed.

Mr. Hatton stated that, if 12 ratings are being submitted, submitters should align ratings one through eight with the Data Preparation Manual. The submission values need to be consistent.
