

Reliability Assessment Committee DRAFT Meeting Minutes Virtual

Day 1—February 27, 2024 1:00 to 5:00 p.m.

1. Welcome, Call to Order

Chelsea Loomis, Reliability Assessment Committee (RAC) Co-chair, called the meeting to order at 1:01 p.m. MT on February 27, 2024. A quorum was present to conduct business. A list of attendees is attached as Exhibit A.

2. Review WECC Antitrust Policy

Enoch Davies, Reliability Modeling Manager, read aloud the WECC Antitrust Policy statement. The meeting agenda included a link to the posted policy.

3. Approve Agenda

Ms. Loomis introduced the proposed meeting agenda.

By consensus, the RAC approved the agenda.

4. Review and Approve Previous Meeting Minutes

Ms. Loomis introduced the minutes from the meeting on October 25–26, 2024.

On a motion by Chifong Thomas, the RAC approved the minutes from October 25–26, 2024.

5. Review Previous Action Items

Daja Bell, Administrative Coordinator, reviewed action items carried over from the RAC meeting on October 25–26, 2024. Action items that are not closed and will be carried forward can be found here.

6. Interregional Transfer Capability Study

Vic Howell, Reliability Assessments and Modeling Director, discussed the interregional transfer capability study (ITCS) with the committee, and provided an overview on ITCS projects, ITCS phases, and NERC AG success poll results. The presentation is posted on the WECC calendar.



7. Studies Subcommittee

Thomas Carr, Studies Subcommittee Chair, updated the committee on increasing the amount of distributed resources, potential changes to the path rating process, and studies that are underway.

8. System Review Subcommittee (SRS)

Jefferey Anderson, SRS Co-chair, provided a high-level update on the SRS, changes to the Data Preparation Manual (DPM), summer base cases with path reversals, DPM rate changes, and FERC Order 886.

9. Modeling and Validation Subcommittee (MVS)

Song Wang, MVS Chair, updated the RAC on the MVS and discussed with the committee renewable modeling updates, grid-forming inverter modeling, power plant modeling updates, GENTPJ model review, GENQEC readiness and challenges, load modeling updates, and active transmission system modeling. 10. RAC Nominating Committee

The RAC discussed the RAC Nominating Committee and voted on the Nominating Committee Recommendation. The RAC decided to nominate Chelsea Loomis to continue conducting business as the RAC Co-chair. The presentation is posted on the WECC calendar.

11. RAC Steering Committee Update

Mr. Davies discussed the work the RAC Steering Committee is preforming and best practices going forward. The committee decided to move forward only scheduling RAC Steering Committee meetings as needed.

12. Production Cost Data Subcommittee (PCDS)

Kevin Harris, PCDS Co-chair, updated the committee on the PCDS.

13. Long-term Transmission Planning Task Force (LTPTF)

Allison Auld-Hill, LTPTF Co-chair, updated the RAC on the LTPTF. Ms. Auld-Hill went over discussions to date, potential use cases identified to date, and background studies used. The presentation is posted on the WECC calendar.



14. Short-circuit Modeling Subcommittee (SCMS)

Amos Ang, SCMS Chair, updated the committee on progress of the SCMS, short-circuit duty cases, sim formats, modeling of inverter-based resources, and dynamic link libraries.

15. RRC/RAC Coordination: Event and Performance Analysis Subcommittee (EPAS)

Alan Wahlstrom, EPAS Chair, updated the RAC on the EPAS and provided an overview on the NERC event analysis process. The presentation is posted on the WECC calendar.

16. ESIG Weather Dataset

Justin Sharp, Sharply Focused, discussed the ESIG weather dataset, evolving weather and weather education, electric system weather dependence, power system models, wind and solar storage, climate change, and what is needed for the weather dataset. The presentation is posted on the WECC calendar.

17. WestTech

Chelsea Loomis discussed the WestTEC study with the committee. The study is still under development, and a steering committee has been formed for the study. More information about the study will be available at the March board meeting.

18. NERC Electromagnetic Transient Modeling Task Force (EMTTF)

Aung Thant, NERC, presented on NERC's EMTTF, its strategies, its support of EMT adoption across NA, and its work items.

19. WECC EMTTF

Philip Augustine, RAC Co-chair, discussed retiring the WECC EMTTF. The committee voted to approve the retirement of the task force.

On a motion by Phillip Augustin, the RAC approved the retirement of the WECC EMTTF.

20. Data Management Project Update

Mr. Davies gave an update on the Data Management Project; the project is in progress. The Data Management Project team is discussing next steps with vendors and internally.



21. FERC Order 881 (Ambient Adjusted Ratings)

Ms. Loomis discussed the FERC Order 881 and ambient adjusted ratings and submitting potential risks to the Reliability Risk Registry.

22. MOD-029 Retirement

Mr. Augustine discussed MOD-029 retirement, the six MOD standards that NERC will be retiring, and asked the committee questions about the retirement of the standards.

23. TPL-008-1

Dmitry Kosterev, Bonneville Power Administration; David Le, California Iso; and Hayk Zargaryan, Southern California discussed the TLP-008-1 standard, FERC Order 896, the NERC Project 2023-07 Drafting Team, planning cases for extreme heat and extreme cold weather events, extreme temperature assessments, continencies and performance criteria, and standard drafting team next steps with the committee. The presentation is posted on the WECC calendar.

24. Engagement Survey Result

Mr. Davies discussed the Joint Guidance Committee's engagement survey results and the feedback from the survey.

25. RAC Three-year Work Plan

Mr. Davies updated the committee on the RAC's Three-year Work Plan and showed members where they can find the work plan.

26. Plexos to Gridview Comparison

Katie Rogers discussed the differences between the Plexos application and the Gridview application with the committee.

27. Public Comment

Ms. Loomis discussed the results received from the July in-person meeting poll. The committee decided to have a hybrid meeting for the July 9, 2024, RAC meeting.
