#### 6. Data for Flow Reversals Seen on the COI

Ben Hutchins, Western Power Pool (WPP), presented the data for flow reversals as seen on the California-Oregon Intertie (COI) and Pacific DC Intertie (PCDI). A proposal was made for targets in the 2025 Base Case Coordination Schedule to do a one-to-two-year case schedule of about 1.5 gigawatts (GW) south to north, that would increase to 2 GW in the five-year horizon and 2.5 GW in the 10-year horizon.

On a motion by Christopher Lamb, the SRS approved the Updated Heavy Winter Path Flows.

#### 7. Autumn Operating Cases

Raja Thappetaobula, California Independent System Operator (CAISO), presented and lead the discussion on the possibility of building an Autumn operating case. The SRS discussed whether there would be a benefit to building an autumn case or whether it would be too similar to a spring case. Mr. Thappetaobula will submit a request for an autumn case.
