### 1. Welcome, Call to Order

Jeffrey Anderson, System Review Subcommittee (SRS) Chair, called the meeting to order at 10:03 a.m. MT on June 13, 2024. A quorum was present to conduct business. A list of attendees is attached as Exhibit A.

### 2. Review WECC Antitrust Policy

Logan Affleck, Associate Engineer II, read aloud the WECC Antitrust Policy statement. The meeting agenda included a link to the posted policy.

## 3. Approve Agenda

Mr. Anderson introduced the proposed meeting agenda.

On a motion by Slaven Kincic, the SRS approved the agenda.

## 4. Review and Approve Previous Meeting Minutes

Mr. Anderson introduced the minutes from the meeting on April 11, 2024.

On a motion by Jerod Vandehey, the SRS approved the minutes from April 11, 2024.

#### 5. Review Previous Action Items

Serena Stiehl, Administrative Coordinator, reviewed action items carried over from the SRS meeting on April 11, 2024. Action items that are not closed and will be carried forward can be found here.

On a motion by Logan Affleck, the SRS closed the action item "Submit DPM change request to add seasonal definitions".

## 6. Hydro Generation Modeling Gaps

Slaven Kincic, Pacific Northwest National Laboratory (PNNL), presented on hydro generation modeling gaps in the West and their potential reliability impacts. A case study was conducted using the 2022 Light Spring base case and four scenarios were simulated: Base Case, Only Wind Curtailment, Only Hydro Update, and Wind Curtailment plus Hydro Update.



#### 7. 2025 Base Case Compilation Schedule Dates

Mr. Affleck presented the 2025 Base Case Compilation Schedule (BCCS) dates for approval. There was a question regarding the number of late cases in the last year and whether that is something worth noting in the 2025 BCCS. WECC is working to fill vacant positions and anticipates fewer delays in base case work once those roles are filled.

On a motion by Karen Reedy, the SRS approved the 2025 BCCS Dates

### 8. 2025 Specialized Cases

Mr. Affleck presented options for specialized base cases in 2025, including:

- Annual Survey\_Form\_PGE\_Heavy Summer S to N COI
- Annual Survey\_Form\_PACW
- Annual Survey\_Form OSS

The SRS was asked to approve two of the three options proposed. The subcommittee discussed the proposed approvals, including that the Light Spring cases are similar and that the SRS should approve one of the two. Mr. Affleck asked for the following amendments:

The 2025 SRS Annual Survey\_Form\_PACW was amended as follows:

- "Expected afternoon peak load" was changed to "Expected load"
- The sentence "Batteries are expected to be charging during this time" was added.

By consensus, the SRS approved the Annual Survey\_Form\_PGE\_Heavy Summer S to N COI By a majority vote, the SRS approved the Annual Survey\_Form\_PACW, as amended.

### 9. Data Preparation Manual Change Request for 12 Ratings

Nick Hatton, Staff Engineer, presented the Data Preparation Manual (DPM) Change Request that would support 12 ratings versus 8 ratings for branches and transformers. The SRS discussed the proposed approval item for the DPM Change Request, including the potential impacts of FERC Order 881, the impact on Remedial Action Schemes (RAS), and concerns with the timing and effectiveness of the changes. Due to dissenting views from the members, Mr. Anderson pulled the approval item for a vote. The SRS will continue to look at the ratings and discuss in future meetings.

#### 10. Public Comment

There was a question about when the 2030 Heavy Winter case will come out for review. It is the hope that the base case will be out by the end of next week.



It was reported that a new version of the GE Positive Sequence Load Flow (PSLF) software is estimated to be released in two weeks and should resolve some of the dynamics issues with high-voltage DC converters.
