### 1. Welcome, Call to Order

Jeffrey Anderson, System Review Subcommittee (SRS) Chair, called the meeting to order at 10:05 a.m. MT on October 10, 2024. A quorum was present to conduct business. A list of attendees is attached as Exhibit A.

### 2. Review WECC Antitrust Policy

Logan Affleck, Staff Engineer, read aloud the WECC Antitrust Policy statement. The meeting agenda included a link to the posted policy.

### 3. Approve Agenda

J. Anderson introduced the proposed meeting agenda.

On a motion by Karen Reedy, the SRS approved the agenda.

### 4. Review and Approve Previous Meeting Minutes

J. Anderson introduced the minutes from the meeting on August 8, 2024.

On a motion by Logan Affleck, the SRS approved the minutes from August 8, 2024.

#### 5. Review Previous Action Items

Serena Stiehl, Administrative Coordinator, reviewed action items carried over from the SRS meeting on August 8, 2024. Action items that are not closed and will be carried forward can be found on the WECC website SRS page under the Quick Links.

#### 6. UFLSWG Data Needs

Karen Reedy, Public Service Company of New Mexico (PNM), discussed how base case data improvements can help the Underfrequency Load Shedding Work Group (UFLSWG) perform its analysis. At the October 8, 2024, UFLSWG meeting, the UFLSWG discussed whether the SRS should start requiring more data from base case submitters.

K. Reedy requested that the SRS get the Steady-State and Dynamics Dashboard (SADD) to count for the UFLS LSDT9 card with missing models and have area coordinators review. K. Reedy also requested the Remedial Action Scheme (RAS) models be updated in the dynamics simulations to allow the UFLSWG to model RAS appropriately and have an accurate



representation of the system response, and for the SRS to start modeling any other automatic protection that might not need the RAS definition but would help with voltage control.

K. Reedy will draft a DPM change request for the use of RAS in dynamics, and L. Affleck will draft a data check for loads with missing LSDT9 models.

### 7. Power Flow Impacts on Substation Components

Jameson Thornton, Burns & McDonnell (1898 and Co.), presented on challenges studying overloads on breakers, switches, and bus sections. Due to an expanded model with new bus numbers, additional changes are likely needed, and bus and breaker outages will also be handled differently. J. Thornton recommended having a visual draw file to aid in review of results, as this will help in understanding the physical flows, likely sources, and potential mitigations.

#### 8. LTPTF FERC Order 1920 Case

Allison Auld-Hill, Southern California Edison Company (SCE), discussed FERC Order No. 1920 and the potential for a 20-year power flow case.

The Long-term Transmission Planning Task Force (LTPTF) has been actively discussing the role of WECC in creating cases for LTPTF that will support Order 1920 requirements. It was proposed that WECC is to collect and compile datasets, but not complete any studies, and WECC will extrapolate a process from the 10-year Anchor Data Set (ADS) to 20-year using the best available data and assumptions.

The SRS discussed whether the subcommittee is the correct group to perform the work and the bandwidth of resources.

#### 9. Public Comment

It was asked whether WECC staff could look at the associated material (ASMAT) and see if there is a way to separate battery charging from pumps and motors. L. Affleck will investigate ASMAT reporting of battery charging.
