Overview

Michele Beck is the Director of the Utah Office of Consumer Services, serving since January 2007. In this position, she represents and advocates on behalf of Utah's residential and small commercial consumers of public utilities.

Ms. Beck serves on the Executive Committee of the National Association of State Utility Consumer Advocates and represents public utility consumers in other federal and regional forums.

Ms. Beck has spent over 20 years working on behalf of consumers in the energy industry as a consumer advocate, in a regulatory agency, and in a consumer-owned generation and transmission cooperative. Her career has encompassed resource and transmission planning and policy, rate design, as well as a wide variety of utility and energy policy issues.

Ms. Beck has been a Class 4 member of the MAC since its inception in 2013. She has been an active participant of the MAC contributing in the following efforts:
