



Update on Long-term Transmission Planning Task Force (LTPTF)

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FERC Order No. 1920

- Compliance filing timeline June 12, 2025 (second filing for interregional planning August 12, 2025)
- The compliance filing must propose a compliance date no later than one year after the time of the filing on which the long-term regional transmission planning cycle will commence
 - Latest start date for the new Long Term Regional Transmission Planning process is June 12, 2026
- Transmission Providers could need 20-year models by early 2026 if the cycle starts at the beginning of 2026, rather than mid-year

LTPTF Timeline

- Recommendation: extend the Long-Term Planning Task Force to June 30, 2025 (or Q3 2025 RAC meeting)
 - Main work complete and approved in Q1 2025 RAC meeting
 - Extended time for follow up support for PCDS and SRS
- Proposal: data request for 20-year powerflow and production cost model issued by March 31, 2025
- Proposal: 20-year models available March 31, 2026
 - Assuming existing WECC committee to do the work
 - Assuming receipt of data submittal in six months

Coordination with PCDS and SRS

- LPTF representatives met with both committees
- Workplan and case development already decided for 2025 for both committees
- Need to adjust for Order 1920 compliance requirements – requires direction from the RAC and members
- Options to complete a 20-year case build (need RAC decision):
 - Use existing processes for PCDS and SRS
 - Establish a new task force for 20-year case building

Next Steps

- Develop detailed workplan for finalizing recommendation for approval at Q1 2025 RAC meeting



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
