Anders Johnson with Bonneville Power Administration expressed existing generation should not be moved around to other areas. There will be a continued effort to make generators, then to reach out to data submitters for the ones that can't be aligned with the 2034HS1 power flow.

8. 2034 ADS PCM V2 Follow-Up

Mr. Jensen shared the beginning of the data management table and wants to make it as transparent as possible. There was a demonstration on how the current version works.

9. Keeping Track of GridView Issues

Andrew Fay with WECC gave a presentation on issues and observations. Currently, in the Generator Development status under the simulator control, the retired selection is being used. This means any units with a service status of “true” and that have commission or retired date within the study period are available and being used in the study. The Generator Development status in GridView can allow you to change which generators will be available based on the development status field.
