

Production Cost Data Subcommittee DRAFT Meeting Minutes April 23, 2025 Virtual

1. Welcome, Call to Order

7. Preview of Energy Storage Ramp Rates

Mr. Jensen gave a presentation on pump storage and energy storage ramp rates. Ramp rates are limited to 5% of contracted MW per minute. It is recommended to update all ramp rates to 20 minutes for full output.

Mr. Harris reviewed maintenance and forced outage rates and shared how he used the pc-GAR report.

Mr. Harris reviewed thermal assumptions and shared the combined thermal spreadsheet and how he used it.

10. 2034 ADS PCM V2 Follow-Up

The ADS Simulation Control bus distribution reference 'buses' were updated. Mr. Jensen will contact Hitachi regarding setting recommendations. Hydro PLF below 100% were updated to only include 100 MW and above. Mr. Jensen will report on PLF under 100% by area at the next meeting. Mr. Jensen also relayed information from LADWP that there are no plans to relieve the operational constraint impacting Path 65 (PDCI). Mr. Jensen will create a change case to correct this, and an optional change case to reverse it. WECC will give a methodology overview of the Automatic Placement Tool next week.
