Nathalie Voisin with Pacific Northwest National Laboratory (PNNL) gave a review of hydro dataset that PNNL had put together which was used in the 2034 ADS PCM. Task 1 was updating the fixed schedule power plants and adding the daily fluctuations; the three methods of Flexibility Parameterization were shared. Task 2 was to extend to Canada and have an evaluation at the

provincial and facility levels. Task 3 was to use the reproducible code and documentation to finalize the dataset. Dan Broman covered the hydropower processing mechanics.

8. 2034 ADS PCM V2 Follow-Up

Mr. Jensen gave a review of the 2035 ADS PCM V2. He presented on Unserved Load, Regional Transfers, Annual Energy, Energy by Subregion, Annual Dumped Generation by State and Type, Most Heavily Utilized Paths. Hourly path information was also shared. 2034_ADS_PCM_5-5-2025_ForReview.zip has been posted to the website, and it has been requested to have the PCDS to review and provide feedback. Anuj Patil shared more information on unserved load and where and when it was occurring.
