Welcome, Call to Order

5. Review Previous Action Items

J. Jensen reviewed action items carried over from the PCDS meeting on June 4, 2025. Action items that are not closed and will be carried forward can be found on wecc.org.

The open action item to create the Anchor Data Set (ADS) process for the next cycle was reviewed. J. Jensen will contact WestConnect to obtain information regarding the need to create a V1 case or intermediate cases for the next ADS cycle.

6. 2034 ADS PCM follow-up items

Anuj Patil, Senior Reliability Modeling Engineer, presented the areas where there is unserved load within the Western Area Power Administration—Rocky Mountain Region (WACM) and Public Service Company of Colorado (PSCO). He will reach out to them for a resolution.

J. Jensen shared information regarding the loads with behind-the-meter (BTM) and will update the loads in the case. J. Jensen will post the 2034 ADS Production Cost Model (PCM) V3.1 with

today's updates, place the change cases/scenarios in subfolders on the PCDS team site, and notify the PCDS.

7. Keeping Track of GridView Issues

J. Jensen presented the tracking of GridView issues and led the discussion on long-duration energy storage in GridView. WECC may be testing this feature in the new version of GridView. J. Jensen will connect with BK Ketineni from Pacific Northwest National Laboratory (PNNL) to learn about its use of long-duration energy storage and will share a load area spreadsheet.

The 2025 loads and resources (L&R) will be reviewed in the next ADS PCM. The PCDS would like to use the Long ID field in the power flow as an identifier for the generators and using EIA plant code, EIA unit code, unit ID, and generator name. This process of data input will be finalized through the Anchor Power Flow Task Force (APFTF).

The PCDS opted to reschedule the June 18 meeting to June 25 and the July 2 meeting to July 9.

8. Public Comment

Yi Zhang, California Independent System Operator (CAISO), noted the load increase after adding the BTM PV, and the resource assumptions need to be reviewed by checking with data submitters for future cases.
