Mr. Jensen presented the 2036 ADS PCM schedule. Once the 2036 ADS PCM is completed, WECC will start a 2046 ADS PCM, and an outline should be ready to present at the September 17, 2025, PCDS meeting.

Anuj Patil led the discussion on the updates for the 2034 Anchor Data Set (ADS) production cost model (PCM). WECC plans to conclude the 2034 ADS cycle and move to the 2036 ADS cycle.
