

## Guidance for Selecting Regional Representatives for NERC Resource Subcommittee and Expectations

Sept 30, 2019

## **Purpose of Document**

The intent of this document is to give guidance on approving the WECC regional representatives for the NERC Resources Subcommittee (RS). This document further explains what is expected of those representatives.

## Qualifications

When someone within WECC's regional area requests to become a member of the RS as a regional representative, the person must provide a written summary of qualifications, which WECC personnel will review. This information will be given to the WECC Performance Work Group (PWG) for its consideration and endorsement. Preference may be given to members of the PWG and individuals who can represent different parts of WECC's regional area.

Qualifications for acceptance from WECC may include a history of performing or understanding the following topics:

- Balancing of generation and load;
- AGC controls;
- Inadvertent interchange;
- Primary inadvertent;
- Interconnection frequency;
- NERC Balancing and Control Standards (BAL); and
- Operating Reserves.

## **Regional Representatives Expectations**

As part of the role for the regional representatives, it is expected they will:

- Attend most of the RS yearly meeting;
- Coordinate with the other WECC RS representatives to provide updates on current RS activities at each of the PWG meetings;
- Coordinate with WECC personnel and the PWG on any analysis or studies being performed within WECC's regional area by the RS.

If for some reason a representative is not performing these expectations, WECC may remove the representative from that position and assign someone else.
