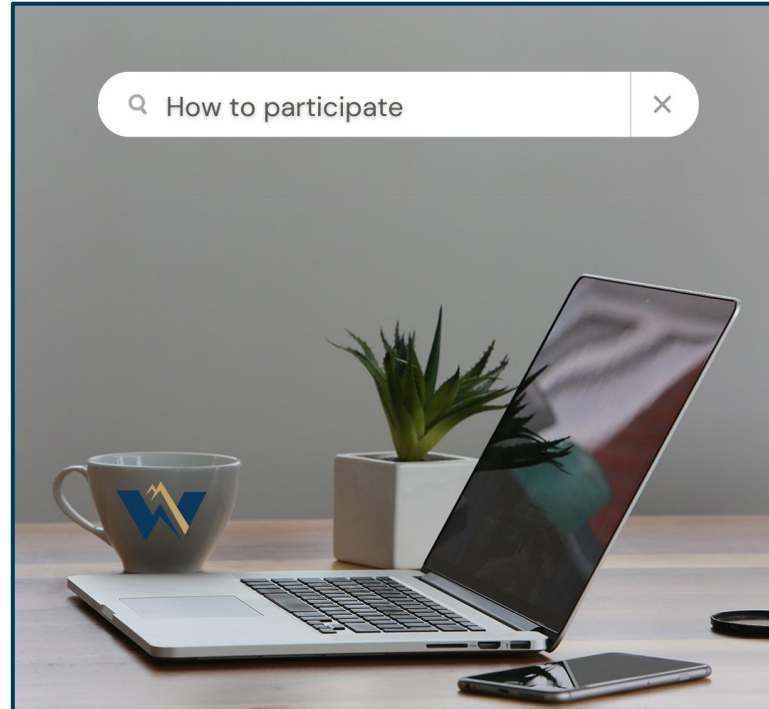

WECC—Standards Projects

- WECC-0142—On 3/6/2025 the WSC approved the project to go out for industry ballot.
- WECC-0155—On 3/6/2025 the WSC accepted the drafting team's recommendation of "No Change," and this project is complete.
- WECC-0156—On 3/6/2025 the WSC accepted the slate of drafting team candidates and authorized drafting to begin. The DT will begin working the first week of April.

Enforcement Processing: Two-Year Comparison

- Current Inventory—**911** (down 8% from high of **989** in August 2024)
- 79%** of inventory reported remediated or mitigated

12-Month Rolling Processing Trends (2-Yr Comparison)	Mar 2023-Feb 2024	Mar 2024-Feb 2025
Inventory Received	420	391
% Self-Logged Inventory (US only)	10%	25%
Inventory Processed	213	400
Net Inventory Change	+207	-9
Mitigation Accepted	146	361
Mitigation Completion Verified	76	39

Enforcement Processing Trends: Self-Report/Log

1-Year Self-Report/Log Trends (Mar 2024-Feb 2025 (U.S. only))	Self-Report	Self-Log
Inventory Received	247 (63%)	90 (23%)
Discovered within 90 days after Noncompliance began	32%	51%
Reported within 90 days of Discovery	26%	41%
Remediated prior to Reporting	90%	99%
Processed as CE	82%	100%
Average Months to Process	6.6	2.9
