1. Welcome, Call to Order

Mr. Jensen led a discussion on C-PAGE Lessons Learned. The main items covered were breakers representation, verifying X and R values match, Fixing regulation generators on busses, check for overloads in generator placements and matching topology.

6. 2034 ADS PCM

Mr. Jensen led a discussion on the 2034 ADS PCM GV enhancements and informed the group that the 2034 ADS PCM is ready to post and will be posted this week.

7. 2036 ADS PCM

Mr. Jensen gave a presentation and led a discussion about the 2036 ADS PCM V1.0 and shared the approach and updates to the case thus far and results. The decision has been made to

proceed with a power flow(pf) unit-based version 1.0 of the 2036 ADS PCM (2025L&R). The implemented tasks for V1.0 were shared as well as the draft results. WECC is still working on finalizing the case. The 2036 ADS PCM V1.0 case will be published on Monday March 2, 2026.

8. Solar and Wind PTCs (Final Review)

Mr. Jensen gave a presentation and led a discussion on the dispatch cost for wind and solar PTCs. The group made some edits and finalized the decision.

9. Projects Under Construction Review

Mr. Jensen gave a presentation and led a discussion on the updates on the projects under construction. The group discusses a process moving forward.
