5. 2036 ADS PCM V2.0

Mr. Jensen gave a presentation on the approach. The group discussed different approaches to the methodology of V2.0. They discussed whether they should use the unaligned power flow units or use the unaligned loads and resources (L&R) units. Both can be put in the case, but it was asked whether one set should be enabled to prevent double counting. The group sees value in a power flow only case and an L&R based case.

Mr. Jensen also showed the difference in non-conforming load, comparing the 2034HS1 and 2036HS1 power flows. He also followed up on some action items from last meeting.

6. Projects Under Construction Review

Mr. Jensen and Mr. Anuj Patil gave an overview of projects in the 2026 L&R and EIA projects under construction.
