#### 5. 2036 ADS PCM V1.1

Mr. Jensen gave an update on the 2036 ADS PCM V1.1 and shared the changes made. It was discovered that there were a few L&R units that were turned on and a few power flow units that were turned off. The changes have been made and a version posted on the team site. WECC received word from PNNL that it does match the 2036HS1a PF.

#### 6. 2036 ADS PCM V2.0

Mr. Jensen spoke about the status of the 2036 ADS V2.0. WECC is still in the process of generator mapping and comparing all the 25 L&R and 26 L&R to the ADS PCM and the matching power flow. Mr. Jensen and Mr. Harris shared the generator location review spreadsheet. Mr. Jensen shared the results from the 2036 ADS PCM V2.0 (2P) draft (power flow units only version) case and

compared it to the 2036 ADS V1.0 (1a) power-flow-units-only case. It is looking good, WECC will clean up the case and post it on the PCDS team site for review shortly.

## 7. Public Comment

Chelsea Loomis shared that there have been discussions on whether WECC will update or maintain a path rating catalog. Over the years it has changed from a reliability-based product to something that is more of a contractually based product. WECC is not in a position to maintain projects for the benefit of economics.
