### 2026 Election Schedule and Rules

The WREGIS Committee elections will be held on September 8 and 9, 2026, with the polls closing at 5 p.m. MDT. The committee comprises seven seats; see the [WREGIS Committee Charter](#) for more information. The following seats on the WREGIS Committee are up for election in 2026:

- **State/Provincial/Voluntary Program Representative**
- **Industry, Other**

### Election Rules

- Members of the WREGIS Committee are elected according to the membership rules outlined in the [WREGIS Committee Charter](#).
- Only registered members of the WREGIS SAC may cast ballots.
- For the WREGIS Committee election, voting entities from each class or subclass may cast one vote for a committee member of the same class or subclass.
- Voting will take place by email.
- Only one delegate per voting entity will have voting rights for that entity. It is the voting entity's responsibility to identify and inform WREGIS staff of a single delegate who will have the voting rights for that entity. Dispute resolution is the sole responsibility of the affiliates involved. If a single delegate is not named, only the first vote cast by an affiliate from that entity will be counted, the others will be discarded.
- Members are elected by a majority of the votes cast for that seat. If no nominee receives most of the votes, there will be a run-off election on September 12 between the candidates who received the most votes.
