



Document Criteria

Documents must be:

- Complete
- Fully executed
- Official
- Pre-existing
- Current
- In an accepted file format



Required Documents

- Commercial Operation Date
- Interconnection Agreement
- Single-line/One-line Diagram
- Power Purchase Agreement
- Proof of Registration Rights
- Proof of Revenue Meter ID
- WREGIS Acknowledgment of Station Service Form





Power Purchase Agreement

- Contract for the sale and purchase of power from a generator that may include:
 - Term and rates.
 - Description of generator.
 - Rights to environmental attributes.
- Must have no redactions (exception: specific financial information) and be fully executed.
- What if there is no power purchase agreement or registration rights are unclear?



What are registration rights?

Who holds the registration rights?

Common terms

- Environmental attributes, green attributes, RECs, renewable credits, certificates
- WREGIS/Tracking system
- Generator/Facility owner

Registration rights are part of WREGIS's due diligence review process.

Consult your legal counsel on questions of ownership and contractual obligation.


