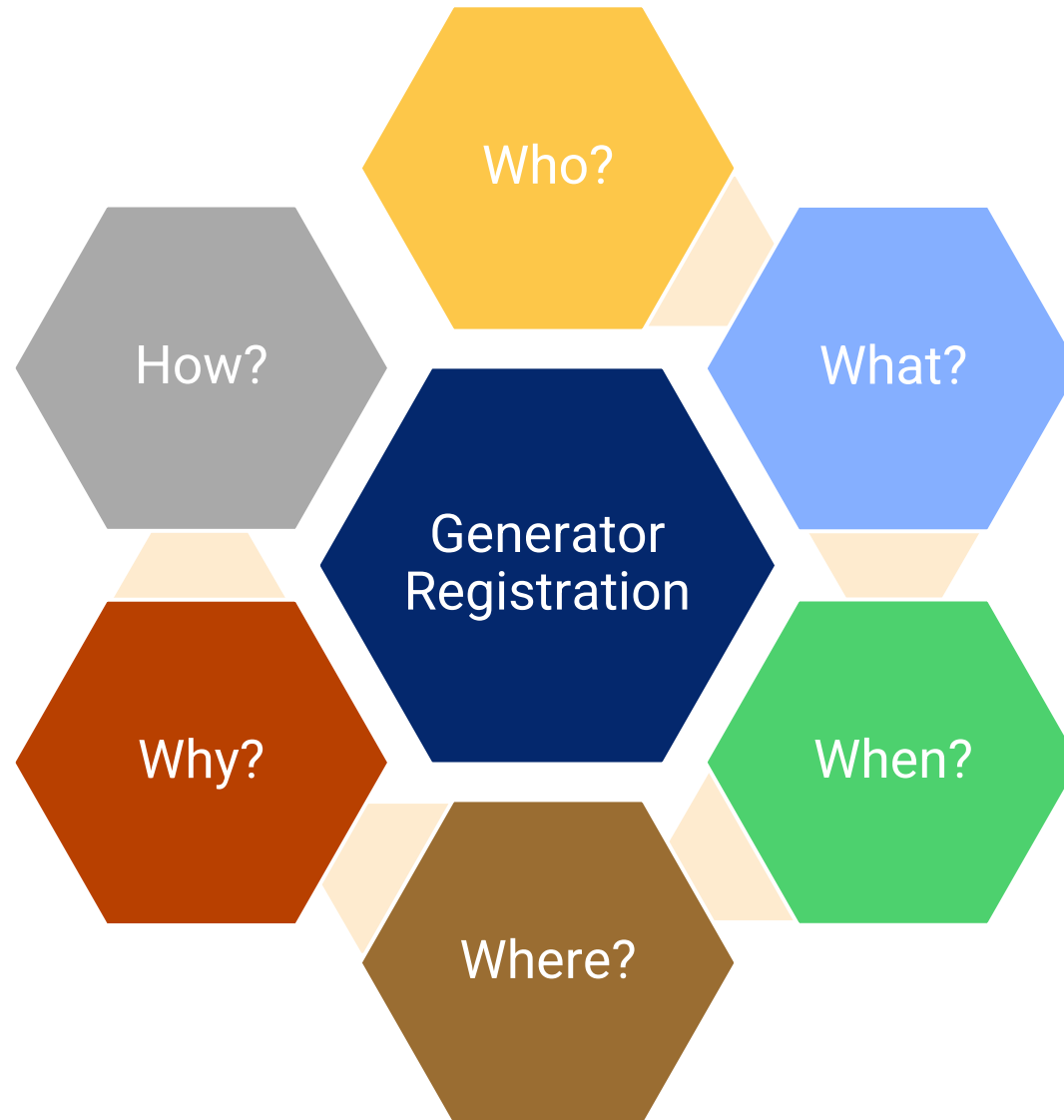

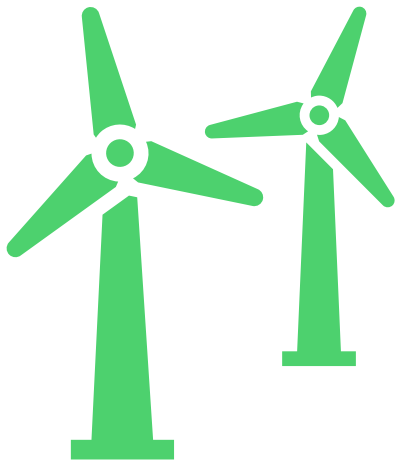

# Who can register? When?

---

## Who?

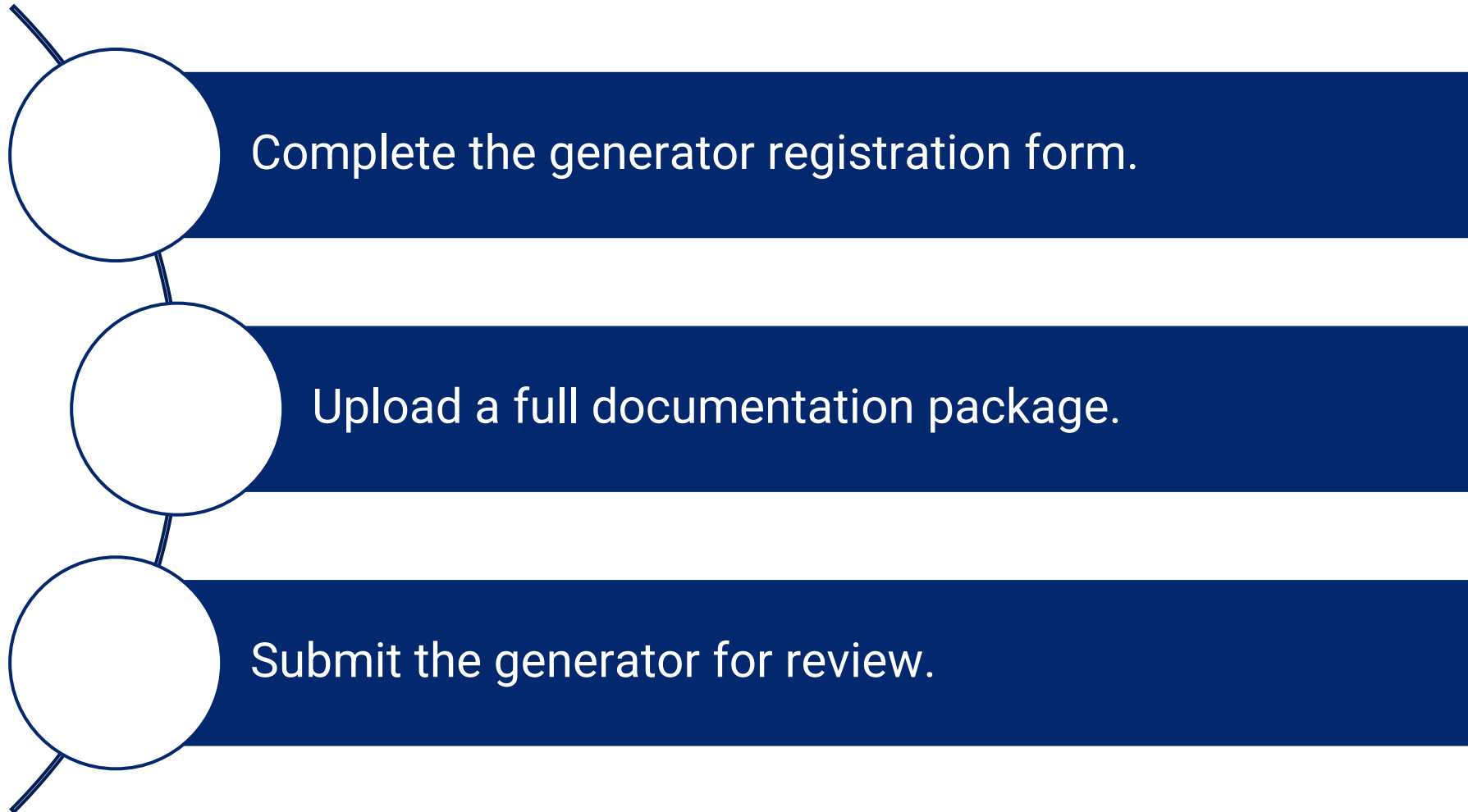
- Must have an active WREGIS organization.
- Must have the rights to environmental attributes.

## When?

- Start generator registration anytime – save a draft.
- WREGIS will not review or approve a generator before the Commercial Operation Date (COD).

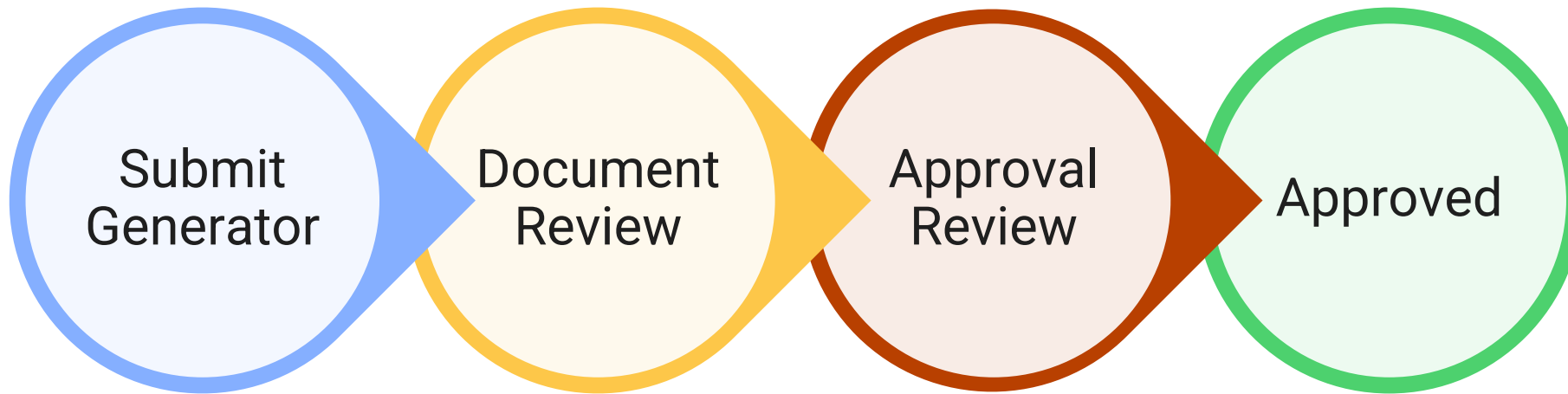






# Review and Approval Process

---



## How far back can I report?

- Generation eligibility is based on the generator **approval** date in WREGIS.
- Three vintages prior approval date.
- Test Energy exceptions are explained in the [WREGIS Operating Rules](#) section 5.3.9.

### Example

Generator Approved: March 2026  
First Eligible Vintage: December 2025

## Tips for Success

---

- Remember to click “Submit Generator” button.
- Submit signed and complete documentation.
- Ensure registration rights are connected to WREGIS organization name.
- Check that the generator is not already registered.
- Respond to WREGIS staff questions in a timely manner.
