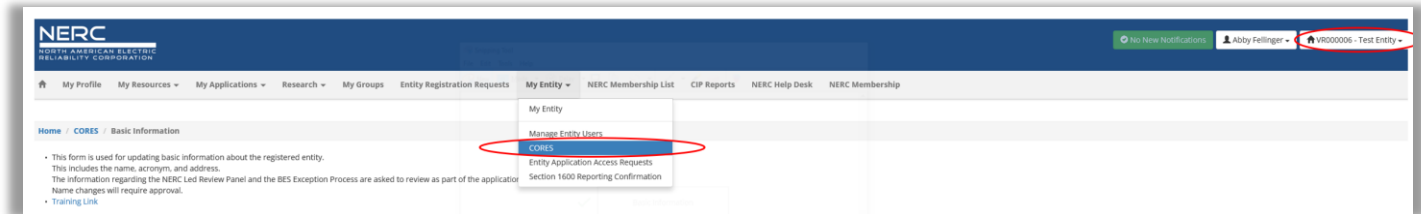


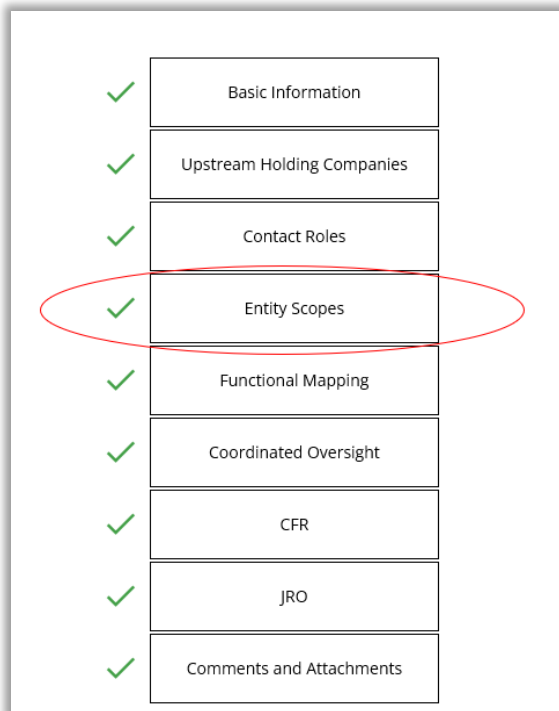
Activating Category 2 GO GOP Functions in CORES

Please follow the instructions below to submit a request to add a Category 2 Generator Owner and/or a Generator Operator Scope (Function) in the Centralized Registration ERO System (CORES).


- Log into the [ERO Portal](#)
- Select the applicable entity from the dropdown box located at the top right side of your menu options
- Select My Entity -> CORES



- Select the **Entity Scopes** section



- To “Activate” a Category 2 Generator Owner and/or Generator Operator Scope (Function), select the **Add Scope** option and fill out all required fields.
 - Enter the applicable required fields: **Function, Proposed Effective Date, Region, Category, Jurisdiction, and Test Power Sync Date**
 - Include a **Note** that explains the reason for the registration change request
 - Select the **Submit** button




