Subject: VEA 2025 Annual Progress Report

Dear Mr. Priye and Mr. Tucker,

In accordance with Western Electricity Coordinating Council project coordination process guidelines, VEA's 2025 Annual Progress Report is provided below.

VEA has no planned generation projects (200 MW or greater) or transmission facility additions over 200 kV, that need to be included in the 2025 Annual Progress Report. Also, there are no planned facilities below these thresholds that may have a significant impact on the reliability of the WECC interconnected electric system.

Note – VEA sold its 230kV facilities to Gridliance West, LLC (GLW) in September of 2017. VEA is a participant, but not a sponsor, in some GLW projects as shown in GLW's Progress Reports to the WECC. VEA retained ownership of its 138kV transmission facilities for which we report on in this document.
