#### **Now Available**

The Western Electricity Coordinating Council (WECC) requested that NERC post **Regional Reliability Standard, FAC-501-WECC-4 – Transmission Maintenance** and the associated WECC-0149 Table Revision Process for industry review and comment in accordance with the NERC Rules of Procedure. Comments are due by **8 p.m. Friday, September 29, 2023.** 

#### **Background**

Proposed Regional Reliability Standard FAC-501-WECC-4 – Transmission Maintenance modifies the currently effective regional standard FAC-501-WECC-2 as follows:

- Conforming the language throughout to incorporate the WECC-0149 Table Revision Process.
- Updating the Compliance section to accept NERC's newest template language.
- Deleting FAC-501-WECC-2, Attachment B, Path Names Identified for Transmission Maintenance and Inspection, and migrating that list into the WECC-0149 Table Revision Process, Attachment A, Major WECC Transfer Paths in the Bulk Electric System.



- Deleting FAC-501-WECC-2, Attachment C, Revision Process, and replacement of that process with the WECC-0149 Table Revision Process.
- Creates a process for modifying the content of the WECC-0149 Table Revision Process, Attachment A, Major WECC Transfer Paths in the Bulk Electric System.

The WECC Board of Directors approved the proposed regional standard FAC-501-WECC-4 and WECC-0149 Table Revision Process on June 14, 2023.

#### **Commenting**

Use the <u>Standards Balloting and Commenting System (SBS)</u> to submit comments. An unofficial Word version of the comment form is posted on the <u>Regional Reliability Standards Under Development</u> page.

- Please be mindful of ballot and comment period closing dates. We ask to allow at least 48 hours for NERC support staff to assist with inquiries. Therefore, it is recommended that users try logging into their SBS accounts prior to the last day of a comment/ballot period.

#### **Regional Reliability Standards Development Process**

Section 300 of NERC's Rules of Procedures of the Electric Reliability Organization governs the regional reliability standards development process. Although the technical aspects of this Regional Reliability Standard have been vetted through WECC Regional Standards development process, the final approval process for a Regional Reliability Standard requires NERC publicly to notice and request comment on the criteria outlined in the unofficial comment form.
